The Crafts Association of BC (CABC) is hosting a gala reception on Sat., Sept 15, in celebration of Craft Year 2007 and the opening of the exhibition *Contemporary Craft in BC: Excellence within Diversity* at the Roundhouse Community Arts and Recreation Centre, Vancouver. As one of our fund-raising initiatives on that evening, we're inviting members and friends in the craft community to participate in a **Goblet Grab Challenge**.

What is it? Craft artists/makers are asked to create a goblet for donation, which will be raffled at the event on Sept. 15.

Goblet Criteria: The only criteria are that the goblet hold liquids and be food safe. **Minimum value is \$20 retail.** They can be single, a pair or more. The rest is up to you, the artists!

The goblets will be showcased and raffled that night to our estimated 200 guests, sponsors and supporters, perhaps with a glass of wine and punch in them. They get to take home a unique hand-made goblet at the end of the night. The medium is your choice – wood, glass, ceramic, metal, mixed media, fibre (now there's a challenge!). Create your goblet from scratch, or embellish or fill a pre-existing wine, champagne, martini or other drinking vessel with handmade soap, lotions, chocolates etc. Be creative and have FUN!

Deadline and contact information? Please contact staff at the CABC office via email (craft2007@cabc.net) or call 604 687-6511 to advise your intent to donate a goblet(s) by July 1.

We will be looking for **delivery of the goblets before August 15**, so we can display them appropriately in restaurants and shops around town to promote the event and for marketing use.

Donation form?

To donate goblets, simply fill out the donation confirmation form available on our website at www.cabc.net (under "What's New" and "Craft Year 2007"). Or, call the office and we can fax, mail or email you a copy.

What will be the use of the funds raised? Funds raised from the "Goblet Grab Challenge" will go towards CABC's commitment to supporting the Craft Year 2007 project, craft artists/makers in our exhibitions program (artist fees) and educational programs for craft artists/makers, students and the public.

Do I get a tax receipt? You are eligible for a tax receipt on the fair market value of the goblet.

Get your creative juices flowing, pass the word, and have some fun with this – at the same time supporting the CABC as we improve and expand our programs and services to meet the needs of BC's craft community.
